Watering Restrictions:

Pursuant to compliance with the Rules for Outdoor Water Use, Chapter 391-3-30, adopted by Board of Natural Resources at its regular meeting on May 26, 2004, the Jekyll Island State Park Authority is adopting the following rules for water use. Under the new rules, water users will be required to follow schedules for outdoor water use during **both** non-drought and during periods of declared drought. Outdoor water use schedules will apply to all outdoor water use on Jekyll Island, Ga. In accordance with 391-3-30-.06 of the "Rules for Outdoor Water Use", local water providers are authorized to implement water use restrictions and additional water use restrictions within their jurisdictions. In addition to these non-drought restrictions, more stringent water use restrictions will be mandatory during declared droughts depending on their severity.

It shall be unlawful for any owner or occupant to utilize water outdoors inconsistent with the mandatory watering schedule stated in the Rules for Outdoor Water Use Chapter 391-3-30, adopted by the Board of Natural Resources.

Upon verbal notice and/or placement of written notice for the first offense, owner or occupant shall have not more than 10 days to correct the non-compliance. If non-compliance occurs again subsequent to the 10-day grace period of the first offense, a second verbal notice (if owner or occupant is available) and a written notice shall be sent by registered mail to the owner or occupant and an additional 10 day grace period from the date of the second offense will be started. If after the second 10 day grace period the so notified owner or occupant has not corrected the non-compliance, the Jekyll Island Authority is authorized and empowered to terminate water service to the said premises.

Outdoor Water use Schedules during non-drought conditions:

- 1) Outdoor water use other than exempted activities shall occur only as follows:
 - a) Odd-numbered addresses: outdoor water use is allowed on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays.
 - b) Even numbered and un-numbered addresses: outdoor water use is allowed on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays.
 - c) No Friday outdoor water use.

Exceptions:

- (1) This rule shall not apply to the following outdoor water uses:
 - (a) Capture and re-use of cooling system condensate or storm water
 - (b) Re-use of gray water in compliance with applicable local ordinances (no sanitary waste).

- (c) Use of Reclaimed wastewater by a designated user from a system permitted by EPD to provide reclaimed water.
- (d) Irrigation for personal food gardens.
- (e) Irrigation of newly installed landscapes is allowed any day of the week, but only during allowed hours for the drought response level in effect, for a period of 30 days following installation. No watering is allowed under Drought response level 4.
- (f) For new landscapes installed by certified or licensed professionals, commercial exemptions apply.

Commercial Water uses:

- (a) Professionally certified and licensed landscapers, golf course contractors, and sports turf landscapers: during installation and 30 days following installation only
- (b) Irrigation contractors: during installation and as needed for proper maintenance and adjustments only.
- (c) Sod producers
- (d) Ornamental growers
- (e) Fruit and vegetable growers
- (f) Retail garden centers
- (g) Hydro-seeding
- (h) Power Washing
- (i) Construction Sites
- (j) Producers of food and fiber.
- (k) Car Washes
- (l) Other activities essential to daily business.
- (m) Watering in of pesticides and herbicides on turf
