

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF JEKYLL
ISLAND AUTHORITY TO REVISE THE STANDARDS FOR OUTDOOR
WATERING OF LANDSCAPE.

WHEREAS, Jekyll Island Authority recognizes an imminent need to create a culture of water conservation and to plan for water supply enhancement during future extreme drought conditions and other water emergencies;

WHEREAS, reasonable restrictions on the outdoor watering of landscape are necessary to address this in furtherance of addressing this need;

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Georgia has required all governments in Georgia to adopt an ordinance to be in effect no later than January 1, 2011 to allow outdoor watering of landscape to be between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. (with certain exceptions); and


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED that the following is adopted as an Ordinance to read as follows:

Outdoor Water Usage 15-116

Outdoor water use schedules during non-drought conditions:

- 1) Outdoor water use other than exempted activities shall occur only as follows:
 - a) Odd numbered addresses; outdoor water use is allowed on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.
 - b) Even numbered and un-numbered addresses; outdoor water use is allowed on Monday, Wednesdays and Saturdays.
 - c) No Friday outdoor water use.
- 2) Outdoor watering for purposes of planting, growing, managing or maintaining ground cover, trees, shrubs or other plants may occur only between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m.
